WHO WE ARE

There are hundreds of Citizen Police Academy Alumni Associations across the United States in both large and small communities. Their members are all graduates of a Police Department's Citizen Police Academy (CPA). These academies are constantly gaining in popularity, in that they educate attendees in the various operations within their Police Department.

Kerrville's first CPA was conducted in 2006. Since that time hundreds of Kerrville residents have completed the course which is presented twice a year. Classes are three hours long, one night each week, for 11 weeks.

Shortly after the first class graduated, a decision was made to form an alumni association. The mission of the Kerrville Citizen Police Academy Alumni Association (KCPAAA) is to continue the education of academy graduates in law enforcement related subjects and provide support to the Kerrville Police Department (KPD) in a variety of ways. KCPAAA volunteers perform ADMINISTRATIVE DUTIES within the department, provide an extra set of eyes and ears on the street through the CITIZENS ON PATROL (COP) program, assist in TRAFFIC CONTROL at parades, provide law enforcement related community services at CIVIC EVENTS, and assist in presenting the CITIZEN POLICE ACADEMY and JUNIOR CITIZEN POLICE ACADEMY. The primary community event of the KCPAAA is the annual BLUE SANTA program. In partnership with the Kerrville Police Officers Association, several local charitable organizations, businesses, and the generosity of concerned citizens, KCPAAA provides children in less fortunate families with clothing and Christmas gifts, along with food items for a complete Christmas dinner for their entire family.

The KCPAAA is constantly striving to improve and increase its support to the KPD. Our continuing goals include:

- Provide ongoing information and education in law enforcement related topics to our members, thereby equipping them with the increased capability to carry out the mission of the KCPAAA.
- Undertake community service projects in support of the KPD.
- Assist the KPD in ways that lessen its administrative and other support burdens, thereby allowing the department to devote maximum effort to core police functions.
- Aid the KPD in handling special events that require manpower beyond the resources of the department.
- Conduct fundraising events to allow the purchase of items not otherwise possible within the KPD budget.
- Advance CPA graduates' interest and involvement in police operations.
- Increase public awareness and rapport between the community and the KPD.
- Assist the KPD in conducting Citizen Police Academy and Junior Citizen Police Academy classes.
- Continue to grow and develop the Kerrville Citizen Police Academy Alumni Association in ways that produce corresponding enhancements in our support to the Kerrville Police Department.



The Kerrville Citizen Police Academy Alumni Association is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization comprised of Kerrville Citizen Police Academy graduates.

As citizen ambassadors to the Kerrville Police Department, we are committed to assisting the department through volunteer activities and other forms of support.
